



Dear Parents

In light of the current situation, St John Paul II classes are looking to provide online learning opportunities for students. We will be trialling SeeSaw (K-Yr 2) and Teams (Yrs 3-6) over the next few days and encourage you to start your preparations to enable this to happen.

We do not know if, or when, schools will shut down, but should they do so, it is possible that it will be for an extended period of time. For your child to access real learning opportunities you will require:

- 1) a suitable device from which children can access lessons, i.e. a laptop computer, an ipad or at the very least perhaps your mobile phone.
- 2) internet access, and
- 3) an up to date email address to make contact with you.

The opportunity over the next few days to have a staged approach towards facilitating online learning gives everyone the chance to work through issues that may arise and so I thank you for your support in enabling this to happen.

I thank staff for their exceptional commitment to make this happen. Most teachers are in the early stages of having commenced the online trial. As we develop our skills in this form of educational delivery, more daily lessons will become available. Please continue to check your email, soon you will receive information and login details to enable your child to begin their online journey.
