

## INFORMATION BULLETIN

Dear Parents

Thank you for your support and understanding throughout this term. It has certainly had its challenges. Please note that commencing next term there will be a further relaxing of restrictions in schools.

### Phase 4 School Operations Guidelines

- The library will open again for students at lunch time
- Incursions and excursions can proceed with appropriate adult physical distancing
- Sport and training sessions are now permitted
- Interschool activities can proceed with adults maintaining physical distancing
- Camps can operate providing they comply with health guidelines
- Assemblies and school community events can proceed with adults maintaining physical distancing
- Choir and band can commence
- School and parent meetings can proceed, entrance to classrooms at the invitation of the teacher

All parents and adult visitors to the school or who attend school based events must continue to maintain physical distancing protocols – one person per 2m<sup>2</sup>.  
Students and staff are encouraged to continue with regular and thorough handwashing.  
If you are unwell, please stay at home.

**Uniform Shop** will re-commence opening from Term 3. Social distancing will continue so we ask you please line up and wait to be called into the room by our volunteers.  
Opening hours will be every Thursday, 8:15 to 9:00am & 2:30 to 3:15pm.

**Children's School Banking** will re-commence in Term 3. The new banking day will be Wednesday. Please ensure school banking books are into the office prior to 11am. Late banking is unable to be processed.

We continue to review and respond to protocols in line with advice from the Department of Health. There continues to be a relatively low risk of Covid-19 transmission in schools amongst children.

A reminder that the last day of school this term for children is tomorrow, Wednesday 1 July. Term 3 commences on Monday, 20 July. I will be taking some leave and will be back on 10 August.
