Vacation Care:

Recipe:

Zucchini Muffins

- 1 zucchini
- 2 cups pancake mix
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 2 eggs
- 3/4 cups brown sugar
- 1/4 cup apple sauce
- 2 teaspoons lemon juice

1. wash zucchini and cut off ends
2. grate zucchini and use a paper towel to dry the zucchini once done.
3. preheat oven to 180 degrees
4. line a muffin tin with 12 cases
5. In a bowl, mix the pancake mix with the spices.
6. In separate bowl- whisk eggs, sugar, apple sauce and lemon
7. fold the egg mixture into the shredded zucchini and pancake mix.do not overmix
8. spoon mixture into muffin cases
9. bake for 10-15 minutes.
10. remove and leave to cool.
