<p>4.1.</p>	<p>Discussed planning for Mothers day Stall. Agreed to look at gifts needed for Grandmothers later and purchase in store instead of adding to our online order. A preparation day of sorting and wrapping gifts etc will be done on the 1<sup>st</sup> day back of term as long as gifts have arrived by then. Order forms to go out before the end of term.</p>	
<p>4.2.</p>	<p>Discussed Easter Egg Hunt, decided a text needs to go out ASAP and a note to be in the next newsletter asking for donations so there is time to sort them out before hand. The easter egg hunt will be on the Friday the 12<sup>th</sup> of April (last day of term) and the Thursday for the other kindy class.</p>	
<p>4.3.</p>	<p>Lisa proposed ways to help make Saint John Paul ii a waste free school by Exploring Terra Waste and Green batch Schools Recycling of bottles etc</p> <p>A few things are being put in place throughout the school with extra recycling bins so other ideas will be explored at a later date. It was agreed that we would donate \$90 from the P&amp;F towards a pen and texta recycling box to be in and central area in the school for these items to be recycled. Also we will have extra recycling bins at P&amp;F events in the future.</p>	
<p>4.4.</p>	<p>Playgroup – Mrs Ring put forward a request for help from the P&amp;F for a new drying rack for playgroup. It was discuss and voted for an allowance of approx. \$100. Will confirm with Quotes and next meeting.</p>	

4.5.	Reflected on opening of Nature Play area. It was decided some pictures should go in the newsletter so parents who are unable to get to the school to have a look can see what the fundraising has contributed to. Discussed the bus and suitable materials that could be used to complete this part of the nature play area. Tyres filled with sand were suggested to be used as seats but the idea has to be put to the grounds keeper as he will have to put it all together.

It was suggested maybe we do open night later in the year when there will be more of the students work completed on display in the classrooms. 4.7.	It was proposed to Mr Lamb that he ask the teachers what recourses they need for the classrooms so we could donate towards this, as we have to use some of the funds raised last year.	
4.8.	It was brought to our attention that the older year groups would like more equipment on the oval so a suggestion box was discussed to get some feedback from them on what they would like. Then we can decide on something and look at planning for this.
